Professional Learning Developing a Lens to Critically Examine Curriculum

This professional learning session works with teams of teachers to develop their lens to look critically at curriculum and deepen their ability to ask questions about the inclusion of diverse perspectives. Participants build understanding of five domains for examining curriculum using examples from their context. May be delivered virtually or in person.



Curriculum Representation Inventory Applying 5 Domains to Examine Current Curriculum

With guidance from Lessoncast facilitators, teams of teachers use the Curriculum Representation Inventory to apply five domains for examining their curriculum. Each teacher will receive a full set of materials with domain rationale, scoring tools, and reflection questions.



Findings Discussion Reflecting to Inform Action

Participating teacher teams bring their findings and reflections from the Curriculum Representation Inventory. Through a guided process, participants identify gaps and next steps for designing a more inclusive curriculum. Professional learning includes how to use the inventory materials as rubrics for future curriculum evaluation. By the end of the session, teacher teams establish an action plan with immediate next steps for implementation.
